Accelerating Internet of Things: The oneM2M App-ID Registry

What: oneM2M in conjunction with ATIS and iconectiv will present a webinar entitled Accelerating the Internet of Things: The oneM2M App-ID Registry, Thursday, January 14, 2016, 11:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. ET. This webinar will explore how the potential of the oneM2M specification can be realized via the recently launched oneM2M App-ID registry and what developers need to do now to secure their spot in the global M2M marketplace.

oneM2M, the global standards initiative for Machine to Machine (M2M) and the Internet of Things (IoT), has designated ATIS, a oneM2M founding partner, as the initial Registry Management Authority for the App-ID registry. The oneM2M app-ID registry has been developed by iconectiv under the auspices of ATIS.

Background: With M2M communications and the IoT quickly evolving, a foundation is needed to enable the burgeoning number of applications developed on different networks and platforms to exchange information easily and seamlessly. Developed under the direction of a consortium of eight global standards bodies, the emerging oneM2M specification enables that exchange. It is a critical factor helping accelerate the adoption of open M2M systems.
