1. Call To Order

3. IFONE/HNI Issue Update

Chairman Richenaker noted that the purpose of the call was to discuss the ongoing issue surrounding IFONE's request for an HNI for U.S. Department of Defense use in Afghanistan, first brought to the IOC's attention at the June 4, 2004 IOC meeting. He noted that documents gathered following that meeting were posted as contributions:

IOC/04.06.30.03 - iFone Company Information
IOC/04.06.30.04 - iFone Due Diligence
IOC/04.06.30.05 - Going forward Action Items
IOC/04.06.30.06 - Afghanistan - iFone and the Army

Participants pointed out remaining questions about IFONE such as its legitimacy in providing the service and the applicability of E911 and number portability regulations to the proposed service. The group also expressed uncertainty as to whether IFONE had secured numbers or an interconnect agreement with a PSTN carrier. The group agreed to continue to gather information.
