This is to inform you that the Alliance for Telecommunication Industry Solutions (ATIS) invited Jeffrey Goldthorp, Chief of the Systems Analysis Division of the FCC Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau, to update ATIS members on the cybersecurity aspects of the National Broadband Plan. During the meeting on June 3, the need for the FCC to consider potential unintended impacts of proposed cybersecurity rules was discussed. Among the issues discussed was the need to ensure that any new rules: (1) do not provide "bad actors" with information that can be used to harm networks or their customers; or (2) acknowledge the dynamic and global nature of cybersecurity issues.
