On September 12, 2016, representatives from the Alliance for Telecommunications Industry Solutions (ATIS), which serves as the Secretariat for the Administrative Council for Terminal Attachments (ACTA), met via telephone with Susan Bahr, Attorney Advisor with the Commission's Disability Rights Office.

The discussion focused on the potential use of the telephone terminal equipment database maintained by the ACTA for the registration of VoIP customer premises equipment (CPE), subject to the Commission's Part 68 rules, as suggested in the Commission's October 30, 2015, *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in the above-referenced dockets. ATIS noted that it did not see any obstacles to the use of this database for the registration of VoIP CPE. ATIS also agreed to further discuss this matter with the ACTA and provide additional feedback to the Commission on this matter.

Representing ATIS in this meeting were: Thomas Goode, ATIS General Counsel, Alexandra Blasgen, ATIS Manager of Knowledge Services, and Mark Cassarino, ATIS Program Services Consultant.
