Among the issues discussed was the proposal to require the registration of Hearing Aid Compatible (HAC) Customer Premises Equipment (CPE) used with VoIP service in a public database, such as the database of terminal equipment that is administered by the ACTA. There was also discussion surrounding proposed processes by which a hearing aid compatibility standard could be relied on for compliance purposes prior to that standard being adopted through a formal rulemaking process.
