On February 25, 2016, representatives from the Alliance for Telecommunications Industry Solutions (ATIS) Systems SMS/800 Number Administration Committee (SNAC) met via telephone with representatives of the Commission's Wireline Competition Bureau.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss issues previously raised by ATIS SNAC including SNAC's recommendation that the Commission permit the direct transfer between users of Toll Free numbers under certain limited circumstances, the need to accommodate geographic routing of Toll Free numbers during the PSTN transition, and issues related to the hoarding and warehousing of Toll Free resources.
