Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 4, 2023, representatives from the Alliance for Telecommunications Industry Solutions (ATIS) SMS/800 Number Administration Committee (SNAC) met virtually with Justin Faulb, Chief of Staff and Legal Advisor for Wireline and National Security for Commissioner Starks, to discuss ATIS SNAC's request for guidance regarding the distribution for Toll-Free Numbers (TFNs) that have been made unavailable at the direction of the Federal Communications Commission (Commission).

The following representatives from ATIS SNAC were present at this meeting: Michael Gilbert ATIS SNAC Co-Chair, iconectiv; Joel Bernstein, Vice President, Regulatory and Public Policy, Somos; Jackie Wohlgemuth, Director of Global Standards Development, ATIS; Jen Huynh, Coordinator, ATIS; and Thomas Goode, General Counsel, ATIS.

ATIS SNAC noted that, as explained in its June 28, 2022, ex parte in the above-referenced dockets, there are over 45,000 TFNs that have not been allocated. These unallocated TFNs, include over 30,000 "833" TFNs and nearly 16,000 "800" TFNs.

ATIS SNAC further explained that it has asked the Commission to instruct the Toll Free Numbering Administration to release the 15,978 "833" TFNs into the spare pool as soon as possible so they can be available to businesses who wish to use the numbers.

Given the anticipated demand for the "800" numbers, ATIS has recommended that the Commission consider an equitable allocation method under which the unassigned "800" TFNs would be made eligible for allocation but with an allocation limit of 125 numbers per Resp Org (with all affiliates counted as a single Resp Org).
